Learn to "Stop" Inappropriate Activity Before It Happens

Child safety tip: Teach your child to respect the word "stop!" Teach your preschooler that "stop" means "stop," and that your child has the right to stop people from touching his or her body. Obviously, exceptions will have to be made for doctors and parents, but even parents must listen when a child doesn't want to be tickled or hugged anymore. Reinforcing this excellent lesson gives your child the power to recognize—and to stop—"bad touching" by others if it should happen.

Reforzando esta excelente lección le da a su hijo el poder de reconocer, y de detener, el "mal contacto" por parte de otros si esto sucede.

Musical Notes

Easter Sunday brings the Paschal Triduum to a close. The church's long tradition tells us that Holy Week's historical events merge into the mystery of our liturgical/sacramental celebrations. The music for today and this past week seeks to capture that spirit. The sacred music for Holy Week spans over a thousand years from the 11th century right up to 2010. It draws on Latin chants dating back to the time of Notre Dame's construction, baroque compositions from Bach's era, spirituals and contemporary music to capture the mystery of the Triduum.

The service opens with hymn #540 "**Jesus Christ is Risen Today**" with its verses translated from a 14th century Latin text. The Easter Psalm is #81 "**Let us Rejoice**" and the Sequence is "**Christians, Praise the Paschal Victim!**" (#1065). For the sprinkling of Baptismal Water, we sing #205 the **Sprinkling Song** from the Mass of Peace and Joy written in 2010. For the Preparation meditation, the choir captures all of our feeling for "Love so amazing, so divine demands my soul, my life, my all!" in "**When I Survey the Wondrous Cross**". Let us recall Jesus's triumph over death and the gift of faith as we sing "**O Sons and Daughters**" (#532) for Communion. The service closes with #881 "**Lift High the Cross**".

The Ordinary parts of the Mass use both English and Spanish verses from the **Misa Santa Fe** (copies available on the bookcase in the rear of the church and on the two music stands at the front) for Holy Thursday and the Easter Vigil and English on Easter Sunday. The Gloria is sung again starting on Holy Thursday, and at Easter the **Gospel**



- ◆ Insure effective communication. Manage the telephone system; parish and master calendar; the publication of weekly bulletin, advertising and other internal communications.
- ◆ Interface with parish ministries and Parish Council as required.
- ◆ Attend and record all Finance Council meetings.
- ◆ Interface with Trustees as appropriate
- ◆ Insure that all employees, and volunteers have Background Checks and Safe Environment Training, as required by the Diocese of Cheyenne
- ◆ Other responsibilities as indicated by Pastor.

He/she is a self-starter, a natural leader, has excellent organizational skills, strong interpersonal verbal and written skills, and multi-task oriented. 


