- ♦Insure effective communication. Manage the telephone system; parish and master calendar; the publication of weekly bulletin, advertising and other internal communications.
- ♦Interface with parish ministries and Parish Council as required.
- **★**Attend and record all Finance Council meetings.
- ◆Interface with Trustees as appropriate
- ◆Insure that all employees, and volunteers have Background Checks and Safe Environment Training, as required by the Diocese of Cheyenne
- **♦**Other responsibilities as indicated by Pastor.

Child Abuse Prevention Month:

You cannot always predict who will be an abuser

Experience shows that most abuse is committed by someone who has gained the trust of a victim/ survivor and his/her family. With child sexual abuse, sixty percent of the time the offender is a family friend, acquaintance, or another trusted adult in the victim/survivor's life. Thirty percent of the time the offender is a family member. Sometimes an offender seems like the nicest person in the world, but this is often part of a process they use called "grooming" in order to gain the trust of the child they wish to abuse and the trust of his/her family.

There are behavioral warning signs of child abusers:

Training and education help adults recognize grooming techniques that are precursors to abuse. Some abusers isolate a potential victim by giving him or her undue attention or lavish gifts. Another common grooming technique is to allow young people to participate in activities which their parents or guardians would not approve, such as watching pornography, drinking alcohol, using drugs, and excessive touching, which includes wrestling and tickling. It is also critical to be wary of age-inappropriate relationships, seen, for example, in the adult who is more comfortable with children than fellow adults.

Mes de la Prevención del Abuso Infantil:

No siempre se puede predecir quién será un abusador La experiencia demuestra que la mayoría de los abusos

son cometidos por alguien que se ha ganado la confianza de una víctima / sobreviviente y su familia. Con el abuso sexual infantil, el sesenta por ciento de las veces el delincuente es un amigo de la familia, un conocido u otro adulto de confianza en la vida de la víctima / sobreviviente. El treinta por ciento de las veces el delincuente es un miembro de la familia. A veces, un delincuente parece ser la persona más

amable del mundo, pero esto es a menudo parte de un proceso que utilizan llamado "arreglo personal" para ganarse la confianza del niño que desean abusar y la confianza de su familia.

Hay señales de advertencia de comportamiento de los abusadores de niños: la capacitación y la educación ayudan a los adultos a reconocer las técnicas de aseo que son precursoras del abuso. Algunos abusadores aíslan a una víctima potencial prestándole atención indebida o regalos lujosos. Otra técnica común de aseo es permitir que los jóvenes participen en actividades que sus padres o tutores no aprobarían, como ver pornografía, beber alcohol, consumir drogas y tocar excesivamente, lo que incluye la lucha y las cosquillas. También es crítico desconfíe de las relaciones inapropiadas para su edad, como se ve, por ejemplo, en el adulto que se siente más cómodo con los niños que sus compañeros adultos.


