The days between Easter and Pentecost continue the celebration of the Resurrection and, according to the Wyoming Ordo, provide opportunity to "explore more deeply the weather in our heart, to awaken the memory of God's presence and power in our lives." The Fourth Sunday of Easter continues following Jesus's disciples as they reach out to Jews and Gentiles alike with the message that Jesus is the Lord, the Lamb on the throne who will shepherd his flock to eternal life.

The service opens with hymn #537 "Easter Alleluia", praising God and calling to our Shepherd, (except at the 10:00 a.m. Mass). At the 10:00 a.m. Mass, we sing #886 "Immaculate Mary", honoring our Lord's mother. Following will be #205 "the Sprinkling Song". Psalm #1072 "We Are His People, the Sheep of His Flock" captures the spirit of the Easter season. The Preparation hymn is "The King of Love" (#712), and "You Satisfy the Hungry Heart" (#940) is the communion hymn. The 5:30 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. services close with "Immaculate Mary" (#886) and the 10:00 a.m. service ends with the # 537, "Easter Alleluia".

The Ordinary parts of the Mass are from the Mass for Age to Age, starting on page 248.


