Easter Greetings

In the ancient Russian Orthodox tradition, the day after Easter was devoted to sitting around the table telling jokes. Even in church they told them! And why? Well, this was the way, they felt, that they were imitating the cosmic joke that God had pulled on Satan in the resurrection.

You see, witnessing Calvary which he had engineered, Satan thought he had won, smiling to himself for having the last word: death. So he thought. Then God raised up Jesus from the dead, and life and salvation became the last words.

So, in Russian Orthodox tradition: a joke as seen on an epitaph from England:

Remember man, as you walk by / As you are now, so once was I. / As I am now, so shall you be, / Remember this and follow me.

To which some wag replied by scribbling on the tombstone: To follow you I'll not consent / Until I know which way you went.

Easter says we know which way Jesus went, and where we shall follow – because of Him. That is what it's all about and why we laugh and shout the joyous "Alleluia!" HAPPY EASTER!

Saludos de Pascua

En la antigua tradición ortodoxa rusa, el día después de la Pascua se dedicó a sentarse alrededor de la mesa a contar chistes. ¡Incluso en la iglesia les dijeron! ¿Y por qué? Bueno, sentían que así era como estaban imitando la broma cósmica de que Dios le había tirado a Satanás en la resurrección.

Verá, al presenciar el Calvario que él había diseñado, Satanás pensó que había ganado, sonriendo para sí mismo por tener la última palabra: muerte. Eso pensó. Entonces Dios resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos, y la vida y la salvación se convirtieron en las últimas palabras.

Entonces, en la tradición ortodoxa rusa: una broma como se ve en un epitafio de Inglaterra:

Recuerda, hombre, mientras caminas / Como eres ahora, así fui yo / Como soy ahora, así serás tú, / Recuerda esto y ségueme.

A lo que un bromista respondió garabateando en la lápida: Para seguirte no consentiré / Hasta que sepa por dónde fuiste.

La Pascua dice que sabemos por dónde fue Jesús y adónde lo seguiremos, gracias a Él. De eso se trata todo y por qué nos reímos y gritamos el alegre "¡Aleluya!"
