I Want You! Who, Me?

"World Day of Prayer for Vocations"

Fr. Walter Burghardt, SJ (1914-2008) wrote before he died, "In the course of a half century, I have seen more church corruption than you have read of. I have tasted it. I have been reasonably corrupt, myself. And yet, I love the church, this living, pulsing, sinning people of God with a crucifying passion. Why? For all the Christian hate, I experience here a community of love. For all the institutional idiocy, I find here a tradition of reason. For all the individual repression, I breathe here an air of freedom. In an age so inhuman, I touch here tears of compassion. In a world so grim and humorless, I share here rich joy and earthy laughter. In the midst of death, I hear an incomparable stress on life. For all the apparent absence of God, I sense here the real presence of Christ."

I don't know the source of the following words, but I can identify with them. "And the Lord said GO / and I said, who, me? / And God said, yes, you. / And I said, but I'm not ready yet, / and there is company coming / and I can't leave my family / you know there is no one to take my place. / and God said, you're stalling, and the Lord said GO. / I said / But I don't want to go / And God said / I didn't ask if you wanted to. / And I said, / Listen, I'm not that kind of person / to get involved in arguments. / Besides, my family won't like it. / And what will the neighbors think? / And God said, Baloney. / And yet a third time the Lord said GO / and I said, do I have to? / And God said, do you love me? / And I said, Look, I'm scared. / People are going to hate me / and cut me to pieces. / and I can't take it all by myself. / and God said, / Where do you think I'll be? / and the Lord said GO / And I sighed, / Here I am .. send me. / Sixty years ago, God sent / and sixty years ago, I went / and here I am bent / but not yet spent / - with the help of a lot of friends." Thank you. Richardton, Bogota, Jackson – all good places to be – whether at the beginning, middle or the end of a monastic/priestly fruitful & joyous ministry.
