Report from your Parish Pastoral Planning Team (May 1, 2021)

As you've been hearing during the Prayers of the Faithful at Mass, our Pastoral Planning effort is focused on the theme "Communion for Mission". A word or two on this theme:

Ever since the beginning, our Church has focused on the fundamental teaching of Jesus Christ known as "communion" or "koinonia". The Church is not just a building. The Church is not just the "institution" (Pope, Bishops, Priests, etc.). The Church is really the "Mystical Body of Christ"---that's all of US! All of us TOGETHER!

So, when we talk about "Communion for Mission" we're talking about how we all join together to accomplish the mission Jesus has given us! That is, to continue His work throughout our own community and in the whole world. When we talk about

"Communion for Mission" we're saying that our "job" as Catholics is not just spending one hour per week coming to Mass. It's figuring out how we can come together (as "community") to live our faith with each other!

Your Pastoral Planning Team has now met 6 times and we now are planning some Goals and Action Steps, many of which are based on input some many of you have offered. Some of these include:

- Begin to engage Middle School and High School Youth in ministries in our parish in a much bigger way. And, begin to work on creating a High School Youth Group
- Hold a special Corpus Christi Mass and Procession on June 6th. This will include a "picnic" with food and music for everyone. This is definitely an effort to come together as "one Community"!
- Hold a "Kermes" (festival) sometime during this summer. This will be an outdoor "parish celebration" or "carnival" which includes games, music, food, raffles, and other activities of folks of all ages—fun for English speaking and for our Spanish speaking sisters and brothers.
- Hold a "Ministries Fair" late this summer, so that everyone understands the many ministries and organizations in our parish. The goal is to have the majority of our parishioners involved in at least one of these ministries/organizations.
- Create a new plan for bringing powerful, spirit-filled, and high-quality Music back to our celebrations, after having had to change this so much over the past year due to COVID-19.
- Focus more on praying and learning more about the current "Year of St. Joseph", culminating in "consecration our parish to St. Joseph" later this year.

As we've said recently, we will continue to work on these six "Action Areas" for our parish:

1. Strong Catholic Youth Ministries
2. Grow into One Catholic Community (Anglo & Latino united)
3. Our Lady of the Mountains Community (lay persons) more highly engaged in all ministries
4. Joyous socialization, sacramental celebrations, outreach, and evangelization
5. Powerful, spirit-filled, and high-quality Music Ministry
6. Formation for Discipleship ("Metanoia")

Please continue to provide your input on this very important work! We believe it is God's work in which we are engaged! Most importantly, let us all prayer for each other: that we may all join in "Communion for Mission"!
