



Doers of the Word

Seeds and storms. Blue, the mule.

Dallas Jenkins has a scene in “The Chosen” which shows Jesus in the kitchen scaling a fish on a chopping board, conversing with Peter and James about the Kingdom of Heaven. It is an amusing scene, as are many others where He is teaching on the lake shore, on a hill side, in the market place, in a boat, in the kitchen or by the well. Think of it: the environs he chooses to be with the people, healing, curing, teaching, laughing, reprimanding. Teaching with stories. Pope Francis says to be a good shepherd you have to smell like the sheep. Well, ok.



He talks about wheat, weeds, fig trees, mustard seeds – things from nature. See the birds of the air. What are they doing? See that seed, see how it’s growing? See that tree that is not producing. What is to be done? There is a hatchet sitting at the foot of the tree. Go figure. Stores of nature bring us to our feet, sometimes makes our jaws drop. What do you do when you gingerly catch a huge exhausted bass from the waters two hours before the opening of bass season?

People of his time had many questions: “Isn’t this the carpenter?” “Isn’t this Mary’s son?” “What’s this wisdom that has been given him?” What are these remarkable miracles he is performing?” Jesus was more than a carpenter; he was also a farmer. Would he tell this story today?

A man slid his pickup truck off a road and ended up in a ditch. A farmhouse was nearby, so the motorist asked the owner if he had a tractor, he could borrow to get his truck back on the road. “Nope, but I got my mule, Blue,” said the farmer. “I doubt a mule is strong enough to pull my truck out.” “You don’t know Blue,” said the mule’s proud owner. So Blue was hitched to the truck. “Pull, Blue!” The truck didn’t move. And the farmer called out, “Pull, Elmer!” The truck moved a little. Then the farmer called, “Pull, Biscuit!” And the truck was free. “Thanks so much,” said the truck owner. “But I have a question. You called your mule by three names. How’s that? “Simple,” said the farmer. “Blue is blind. And if he thought he was the only one pulling, your truck would still be in ditch!”


Jesus has given us the Spirit to be with us always. So why do we think we are pulling alone? He saves the last, the least and the lost!




