What has happened to the celebration of Baptism?

Gone are the preparations, obligations, requirements and questioning of lifestyles and practice, motives and sincerity? Gone is the beautiful ceremony at the end of Lent when you were anointed, when before family and friends and faith community – when you and others had to face west, the place of the sinking sun and darkness and say, “I renounce you, Satan, prince of darkness!”. And then turn quickly to the East, the place of rising sun and say, “I accept you, Jesus, the light of the world?”

Gone are the sponsors, who actually lived the life of Jesus themselves and guided you by their counsel and example?

Gone is the involvement and support of the whole community as people have their children quietly baptized with no one there except some close friends?

Gone are those old baptismal pools shaped either like a womb or a tomb, the one emphasizing new life, the other, death to sin and one former way of life? Perhaps our small basin-like fonts today are emblematic of the diminishing of baptism's meaning.

Gone is the idea that baptism is the most important of the sacraments because it is an initiation rite into love and service, a public declaration that you will seek to live the life of Christ at every moment: at your job, your school, your marriage – even if it costs you?

Gone is the memory of the voice that said to Jesus at his baptism, “You are my beloved, with you I am well pleased.”? Do we think of ourselves as beloved of God and beholders to God?

Gone is that sense of calling, of vocation through Baptism? Has baptism become a mere cultural event like having a birthday party, with no meaning, and with no promise to try and live the gospel?

Let's revisit our own baptismal day with an adult informed mind (and photo?) – date, name of church, priest or deacon – and celebrate the anniversary day with a prayer of thanksgiving for our parents who took us to that church.

¿Qué ha pasado con la celebración del Bautismo?

¿Atrás quedaron los preparativos, las obligaciones, los requisitos y el cuestionamiento de los estilos de vida y la práctica, los motivos y la sinceridad?

Atrás quedó la hermosa ceremonia al final de la Cuaresma cuando fuiste ungido, cuando ante tu familia y amigos y la comunidad de fe, cuando tú y otros tenían que mirar hacia el oeste, el lugar del sol y la oscuridad que se ponían y decir: “Te renuncio, Satanás , ¡Príncipe de la oscuridad!”. Y luego gire rápidamente hacia el Este, el lugar del sol naciente y diga: “¿Te acepto, Jesús, la luz del mundo?”

¿Atrás quedaron los padrinos, que realmente vivieron la vida de Jesús mismos y te guiaron con su consejo y ejemplo?

¿Se acabó la participación y el apoyo de toda la comunidad, ya que las personas bautizan a sus hijos en silencio sin nadie más que algunos amigos cercanos?

¿Atrás quedaron esos viejos estanques bautismales con forma de útero o tumba, uno enfatizando la nueva vida, el otro, la muerte al pecado y una forma de vida anterior? Quizás nuestras pequeñas fuentes tipo palanganas de hoy son emblemáticas de la disminución del significado del bautismo.

Atrás quedó la idea de que el bautismo es el más importante de los sacramentos porque es un rito de iniciación al amor y al servicio, una declaración pública de que buscarás vivir la vida de Cristo en cada momento: en tu trabajo, tu escuela, tu matrimonio. - aunque te cueste?

Atrás quedó el recuerdo de la voz que le dijo a Jesús en su bautismo: "Tú eres mi amado, en ti me complazco". ¿Nos consideramos amados de Dios y espectadores de Dios?

¿Se acabó ese sentido de llamada, de vocación por el Bautismo? ¿Se ha convertido el bautismo en un mero evento cultural como tener una fiesta de cumpleaños, sin significado y sin promesa de intentar vivir el evangelio?

Repasemos nuestro propio día bautismal con una mente adulta informada (¿y una foto?) - fecha, nombre de la iglesia, sacerdote o diácono - y celebremos el día del aniversario con una oración de acción de gracias por nuestros padres que nos llevaron a esa iglesia.
