

Week Update from Fr. D

I am now entering week 7 in my hospital chaplaincy training. The situation has greatly improved in the hospital. There are more vacant rooms in the emergency department. I was the on call chaplain the whole night last Friday and there was no call for me! Still I did not have a peaceful sleep because I was always attentive to any possible calls.

I Had been called to attend to Spanish speaking Catholic patients, heard their confessions, and to a few, the sacrament of anointing, and holy communion. One particular patient received the sad news that she had cancer. She was about to be discharged to recuperate at home. She was Spanish speaking. The chaplain in charge of her unit was a Presbyterian reverend. The day was about to end, and she was just crying. The reverend noticed her sadness and went to look for me and asked if I could just visit to console her. I dropped everything I was doing and went with him. He introduced me to the patient as a Catholic Priest. The reverend left immediately and she told me: "Ay padrecito! Es un gran milagro! Un sacerdote ha venido a verme. Usted es mi angel!" Her sadness turned to joy and became more optimistic. "Voy a luchar!" She was grateful and very happy of my visit, and I was too. I left her room mystified by the power of our faith.

She was already discharged and I pray that she is doing well today. But that experience reminded me of a particular event when Jesus raised a little girl back to life. In the case of that woman, Jesus lifted her spirit and brought her back to hope and joyfulness. Mark 5:41: "He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum!" (which means ' Little girl, I say to you, get up!') Joy was brought back to her soul!



El reverendo notó su tristeza y fue a buscarme y me preguntó si podía visitarla para consolarla. Dejé todo lo que estaba haciendo y me fui con él. Me presentó al paciente como un sacerdote católico. La reverenda salió inmediatamente y me dijo: "¡Ay padrecito! ¡Es un gran milagro! Un sacerdote ha venido a verme. ¡Usted es mi ángel!" Su tristeza se convirtió en joya y se volvió más optimista. "¡Voy a luchar!" Ella estaba agradecida y muy feliz por mi visita, y yo también. Salí de su habitación desconcertado por el poder de nuestra fe.

Ella ya fue dada de alta y rezó para que esté bien hoy. Pero esa experiencia me recordó un evento particular cuando Jesús resucitó a una niña pequeña. Is it possible to be a Christian in today's world? To be a Catholic? To follow the mandates of Jesus in Today's gospel? – love enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, give to all who beg, lend without repayment, be compassionate, not condemn, do not judge, forgive?

What would Jesus say about capital punishment, supreme court decisions legalizing murder, welcoming immigrants, arms proliferation, global warming, racism, etc.? These are our issues, aren't they? Not everyone who calls me "Lord, Lord, will enter the Kingdom of heaven – but by the mandate of today's Gospel!"

Jesus lived everyone of those articles of the gospel and some of his final words on the cross while in crucial agony said, "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." Since we can't **be** the church of the poor at least we can try and be the church **with** the poor.

Jesus delivered a message of love and forgiveness to a crowd (Luke 6:27-38) that has become the foundation of many pacifist movements. Based on this message of love for one's enemies and an avoidance of seeking revenge when one is abused, the Mennonite Church forged its long-term commitment to pacifism. Its founder, Menno Simons, called its members to exhibit peace even though a sign of the true church is "oppression and tribulation for the sake of the Lords' word" referencing Luke 6:28.

The Mennonite story unfolded during the Reformation in the 1500's. Like all Christian denominations in the West, they trace their heritage to Roman Catholicism. The Mennonites, offshoots from the Anabaptists, were Radical Reformers, and their views on baptism eventually led many Protestants and Catholics to oppress them. The Mennonites chose to form their own sect rather than retaliate against their oppressors.

When Jesus spoke these words in today's gospel, some who were listening and following him left and walked away, they couldn't take it. Others stayed. Why? What difference does it make? Does it make a difference to us as an OLM faith community?

El Credo del Evangelio

¿Es posible ser cristiano en el mundo de hoy? ¿Ser católico? ¿Seguir los mandatos de Jesús en el evangelio de hoy? – amad a los enemigos, haced el bien a los que os aborrecen, bendecid a los que os maldicen, dad a todos los que mendigan, prestad sin devolver, sed compasivos, no condenéis, no juzguéis, perdonéis?

¿Qué diría Jesús sobre la pena capital, las decisiones de la corte suprema que legalizan el asesinato, la bienvenida a los inmigrantes, la proliferación de armas, el calentamiento global, el racismo, etc.? Estos son nuestros problemas, ¿no? No todo el que me dice "Señor, Señor, entrará en el Reino de los cielos – ¡sino por el mandato del Evangelio de hoy!"

Jesús vivió todos esos artículos del evangelio y algunas de sus últimas palabras en la cruz mientras en la agonía crucial dijo: "Padre, perdónalos porque no saben lo que hacen". Como no podemos ser la iglesia de los pobres, al menos podemos intentar ser la iglesia con los pobres.

Jesús entregó un mensaje de amor y perdón a una multitud (Lucas 6:27-38) que se ha convertido en la base de muchos movimientos pacifistas. Sobre la base de este mensaje de amor por los enemigos y de evitar buscar venganza cuando se abusa de uno, la Iglesia Menonita forjó su compromiso a largo plazo con el pacifismo. Su fundador, Menno Simons, llamó a sus miembros a exhibir paz a pesar de que una señal de la verdadera iglesia es "opresión y tribulación por causa de la palabra del Señor", haciendo referencia a Lucas 6:28.

La historia menonita se desarrolló durante la Reforma en el siglo XVI. Como todas las denominaciones cristianas en Occidente, remontan su herencia al catolicismo romano. Los menonitas, vástagos de los anabaptistas, eran reformadores radicales, y sus puntos de vista sobre el bautismo finalmente llevaron a muchos protestantes y católicos a oprimirlos. Los menonitas optaron por formar su propia secta en lugar de tomar represalias contra sus opresores.

Cuando Jesús pronunció estas palabras en el evangelio de hoy, algunos de los que lo escuchaban y lo seguían se fueron y se alejaron, no pudieron soportarlo. Otros se quedaron. ¿Por qué? ¿Qué diferencia hace? ¿Hace una diferencia para nosotros como comunidad de fe OLM?



FORGIVENESS, not.....anymore!

Missionaries to Alaska surprised themselves discovering a beautiful expression for *forgiveness*. The word **issumagijoujungnainermik** means not-being-able-to-think-about-it-anymore !! The notion is that one who forgives also forgets. What a liberation for our human heart !!

Forgiveness is a freeing gift & when genuinely offered & sincerely received, it overwhelms us as "**pure grace**" from GOD. The one who is forgiven is freed by the offer of **reconciliation**.
