

How does one forgive the unforgiveable, presuming there is an unforgiveable act? And what if others cannot, will not, or unable to forgive us? These are question that plague the conscience-oriented believer. What do we do? Where do we go? These are tough questions that keep us from having a peaceful and harmonious spiritual life. There is only one place to go – the Gospel.

The gospel is powerful. How does one forgive the unforgiveable? The gospel challenges us with the imperative to forgive. And what if others will not forgive us? Then we turn to Jesus of the Gospel and discover that Jesus Christ will stand in their place. Jesus steps into the shoes of these people and comes to our brokenness and, like the compassionate and forgiving father of the parable, helps us and kisses and says, “all is forgiven.” Do we believe this?

That is why we have the sacrament of reconciliation, confession. It is the one place where we can be reassured that in our sinfulness the Lord Jesus will come and say, “Go in peace, your sins are forgiven, I, on behalf of all those who will not forgive you – I will forgive.”

If I am the one who cannot forgive then, before I die, I’d better come to terms with the gospel. If others will not forgive me, before I die, I must come to terms with Jesus Christ. As Mother Teresa said, “Give thanks for everything you receive, even the problem.”

A few years ago, Stephen Colbert of a TV night show was interviewed by Anderson Cooper. Colbert shared his story of tragedy. When he was ten years old, his two older brothers and father were killed in a plane crash. It took him years to deal with the loss. Being a catholic he came to the conclusion and said to himself: “think of the thing that you most wanted NOT to have happened, and be grateful.” If you are grateful for your life you have to be grateful for everything – I wish that it had not happened, yes, but..” You can’t pick and choose what you are grateful for.

Solanus Casey of Detroit said, “Thank God ahead of time.” Tough stuff. But we get by with a little help from our friend(s) – Jesus.

Hacedores de la Palabra 27 de marzo de 2022, 4 de Cuaresma Perdonar y ser perdonado

¿Cómo se perdona lo imperdonable, suponiendo que hay un acto imperdonable? ¿Y si los demás no pueden, no quieren o no pueden perdonarnos? Estas son preguntas que plagan al creyente orientado a la conciencia. qué hacemos? ¿A donde vamos? Estas son preguntas difíciles que nos impiden tener una vida espiritual pacífica y armoniosa. Sólo hay un lugar adonde ir: el Evangelio.


El evangelio es poderoso. ¿Cómo se perdona lo imperdonable? El evangelio nos desafía con el imperativo de perdonar. ¿Y si los demás no nos perdonan? Luego nos volvemos a Jesús del Evangelio y descubrimos que Jesucristo ocupará su lugar. Jesús se pone en los zapatos de estas personas y llega a nuestro quebrantamiento y, como el padre compasivo y perdonador de la parábola, nos ayuda y besa y dice: “todo está perdonado”. ¿Creemos esto?

Por eso tenemos el sacramento de la reconciliación, la confesión. Es el único lugar donde podemos estar seguros de que en nuestra pecaminosidad el Señor Jesús vendrá y dirá: “Ve en paz, tus pecados te son perdonados, yo, en nombre de todos los que no te perdonarán, yo perdonaré”.

Si yo soy el que no puede perdonar entonces, antes de morir, será mejor que acepte el evangelio. Si otros no me perdonan, antes de morir, debo llegar a un acuerdo con Jesucristo. Como dijo la Madre Teresa: “Da gracias por todo lo que recibes, incluso por el problema”.

Hace unos años, Anderson Cooper entrevistó a Stephen Colbert de un programa nocturno de televisión. Colbert compartió su historia de tragedia. Cuando tenía diez años, sus dos hermanos mayores y su padre murieron en un accidente aéreo. Le tomó años lidiar con la pérdida. Siendo católico llegó a la conclusión y se dijo a sí mismo: “piensa en lo que más querías que NO hubiera pasado, y sé agradecido”. Si estás agradecido por tu vida, tienes que estar agradecido por todo. Desearía que no hubiera sucedido, sí, pero...” No puedes elegir por qué estás agradecido.

Solanus Casey de Detroit dijo: “Gracias a Dios por adelantado”. Cosas difíciles. Pero nos las arreglamos con un poco de ayuda de nuestro(s) amigo(s) – Jesús.



LENTEN REGULATIONS

Easter Triduum April 14-17, 2022

1. By the law of God and the custom of the Church, all Christians are required to do penance.
2. The season of Lent retains its penitential character. The days of penance to be observed under obligation are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of the Lenten season.
3. Abstinence from meat is to be observed on all Fridays of Lent. Both abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 - a. The law of abstinence:
 - i. forbids the consumption of meat
 - ii. binds those who have celebrated their 14th birthday
 - b. The law of fasting:
 - i. permits only one full meal a day
- ii. binds those who have celebrated their 18th birthday and continues until they have celebrated their 59 th birthday.
4. Pastors and parents should take particular care to educate the young to a true sense of penance and self-discipline. More frequent use of the Sacrament of Penance and attendance at daily Mass should be encouraged during Lent, as well as other practices of penance and self-sacrifice.
5. The Fridays of the year outside Lent remain days of penance, but each individual may substitute traditional abstinence from meat with some other practice of voluntary self-denial or personal penance. These works should be considered a minimal response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.

Triduo Pascual 14-17 de abril de 2022

3. La abstinencia de carne debe observarse todos los viernes de Cuaresma. Tanto la abstinencia como el ayuno deben observarse el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo.

un. La ley de la abstinencia:

I. prohíbe el consumo de carne

ii. une a los que han celebrado su 14 cumpleaños

B. La ley del ayuno:

I. permite sólo una comida completa al día

ii. une a los que han celebrado su cumpleaños número 18 y continúa hasta que hayan celebrado su cumpleaños número 59.

4. Los párrocos y los padres deben tener especial cuidado en educar a los jóvenes en un verdadero sentido de penitencia y autodisciplina. Se debe alentar el uso más frecuente del Sacramento de la Penitencia y la asistencia a la Misa diaria durante la Cuaresma, así como otras prácticas de penitencia y sacrificio personal.

5. Los viernes del año fuera de Cuaresma siguen siendo días de penitencia, pero cada uno puede sustituir la tradicional abstinencia de carne por alguna otra práctica de abnegación voluntaria o penitencia personal. Estas obras deben considerarse una respuesta mínima a la llamada del Señor a la penitencia ya la conversión de vida.
