"I know not the man!" He cried out. The cock crowed. The deed was done and Peter slunk away scarlet-lettered forever. Really?

And the remaining eleven? One of them betrayed him, another would not believe in him, and two boasted they would always be at his right and left but not show up at Calvary where Jesus had to settle with two thieves. Three of them slept in the garden when they should have comforted him, and all of them fled and left Jesus in the lurch when he needed them most.

But the failures, shame, and scandal did not stop them. They regrouped, went back to Jesus and his message, and wound up giving their lives for him. They couldn't undo the sin, the weakness, or the public failures. They couldn't erase the blot, but they could renew their love for Jesus and spread his gospel. And they did.

Fast forward 2000 years. USA. One out of six Americans gets their health care from a Catholic institution. One out of five Americans living in poverty is served by the Catholic Church. Catholic schools are the largest providers of private K-to-12 education in a country with more than 2 million students, and the largest provider of private higher education enrolling more than one million students. The national Catholic graduation rate is 99.4 percent of high school students and of these graduates, 84.9 percent go on to college compared to 39.5 percent of public-school graduates.


The Catholic Church is the largest settler of refugees in the country. The U.S. based Catholic Relief Services serves nearly 100 million people in need in 93 countries. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul serves over 14 million people in need in the U.S. each year.

The Catholic Church is and has been the most important nongovernmental source of social good in our nation. And it all started with a weak man who caved in under pressure.

"¡No conozco al hombre!" Gritó. El gallo cantó. La escritura estaba hecha y Peter se escabulló con letras escarlatas para siempre. ¿En serio?

¿Y los once restantes? Uno de ellos lo traicionó, otro no quiso creer en él, y dos se jactaron de que siempre estarían a su derecha e izquierda pero no se presentarían en el Calvario donde Jesús tuvo que conformarse con dos ladrones. Tres de ellos durmieron en el jardín cuando debieron consolarlo, y todos huyeron y dejaron a Jesús en la estacada cuando más los necesitaba.

Pero los fracasos, la vergüenza y el escándalo no los detuvieron. Se reagruparon, volvieron a Jesús y su mensaje, y terminaron dando la vida por él. No pudieron deshacer el pecado, la debilidad o los fracasos públicos. No pudieron borrar la mancha, pero pudieron renovar su amor por Jesús y difundir su evangelio. Y lo hicieron.

Avance rápido 2000 años. ESTADOS UNIDOS. Uno de cada seis estadounidenses recibe atención médica de una institución católica. Uno de cada cinco estadounidenses que viven en la pobreza es atendido por la Iglesia Católica. Las escuelas católicas son los mayores proveedores de educación privada K-to-12 en un país con más de 2 millones de estudiantes y el mayor proveedor de educación superior privada que inscribe a más de un millón de estudiantes. La tasa nacional de graduación católica es del 99,4 por ciento de los estudiantes de secundaria y de estos graduados, el 84,9 por ciento van a la universidad en comparación con el 39,5 por ciento de los graduados de escuelas públicas.

La Iglesia Católica es el mayor colono de refugiados en el país. Los Servicios Católicos de Ayuda con sede en los EE. UU. atienden a casi 100 millones de personas necesitadas en 93 países. La Sociedad de San Vicente de Paúl atiende a más de 14 millones de personas necesitadas en los EE. UU. cada año.

La Iglesia Católica es y ha sido la fuente no gubernamental más importante de bien social en nuestra nación. Y todo comenzó con un hombre débil que cedió ante la presión.
