A skeptic said to a priest, "If you really believe what you preach, then I make you a challenge. Drink this poison here and if you don't die, I'll believe." The priest responded, "I have a better idea. You drink the poison and I'll raise you up!"

Some of you may have seen the 2010 film "Hereafter". It's about a man named George who can communicate with the dead. It is an interesting film even though it doesn't mention religious belief or relationships between behavior and consequences.

Do we believe in the hereafter? Professor Paul Meyers of the University of Portland's Health Center in Oregon in an article in the University's magazine (Fall, 2010) tells the story of three men walking a trail in Yellowstone National Park, fly rods in hand. Suddenly, one stopped and said, "There's my dad coming down the trail!" The other men stopped also. No one spoke. A hawk sailed over. The wind combed through the pines. The man's father had been dead for many years. He had often taken his sons fishing in Yellowstone as the boys were growing up. C.S. Lewis once wrote, "If the duck has a yearning to swim, well, there is water; a flower to grow, well, there is sunlight; a child to love, well, there is a mother. Likewise, if we have a yearning to live forever, why should there not be something to satisfy these longings?"

Remember Thornton Wilder's last words in his classic novel, "The Bridge of San Luis Rey": "There is a land of the living and a land of the dead and the bridge is love, the only survival, the only meaning." Love is the key to a world beyond our sight but not beyond our hearts, and sometimes those we love and who love us let us know they've crossed the bridge.

We believe that "what no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the human heart conceived, what God has prepared for those who love him."

Un escéptico le dijo a un sacerdote: "Si realmente crees lo que predicas, entonces te hago un desafío. Bebe este veneno aquí y si no mueres, te creeré". El sacerdote respondió: "Tengo una idea mejor. ¡Bebe el veneno y te resucitaré!"

Algunos de ustedes pueden haber visto la película de 2010 "Más allá". Se trata de un hombre llamado George que puede comunicarse con los muertos. Es una película interesante aunque no menciona creencias religiosas o relaciones entre comportamiento y consecuencias.

¿Creemos en el más allá? El profesor Paul Meyers del Centro de Salud de la Universidad de Portland en Oregón en un artículo de la revista de la Universidad (otoño de 2010) cuenta la historia de tres hombres caminando por un sendero en el Parque Nacional de Yellowstone, con cañas de mosca en la mano. De repente, uno se detuvo y dijo: "¡Ahí viene mi papá por el sendero!" Los otros hombres también se detuvieron. Ninguno habló. Un halcón pasó volando. El viento peinaba los alfileres. El padre del hombre había muerto hacía muchos años. A menudo había llevado a sus hijos a pescar en Yellowstone mientras los niños crecían. C.S. Lewis escribió una vez: "Si el pato anhela nadar, bueno, hay agua; una flor para crecer, bueno, hay luz del sol; un hijo al que amar, bueno, hay una madre. Del mismo modo, si tenemos el anhelo de vivir para siempre, ¿por qué no debería haber algo que satisfaga estos anhelos?".

Recuerde las últimas palabras de Thornton Wilder en su novela clásica, "El puente de San Luis Rey": "Hay una tierra de vivos y una tierra de muertos y el puente es el amor, la única supervivencia, el único significado". El amor es la llave a un mundo que está más allá de nuestra vista pero no más allá de nuestros corazones, ya veces aquellos a quienes amamos y que nos aman nos hacen saber que han cruzado el puente.

Creemos que "lo que ojo no vio, ni oído oyó, ni corazón humano llegó, es lo que Dios ha preparado para los que le aman".

Volunteer Opportunities

K-12 Literacy Tutor

- **Time Commitment:** 1 hour per week during the school year; and substitutes to be on-call. Full school year commitment.
- **Age Requirement:** Must be at least 15 years of age.
- **Responsibilities:** Provide one-on-one reading and writing support for students in K - 12th grade. Lesson plans are created by TLC staff.

Afterschool Classroom Assistant

- **Length of Commitment:** 1 -2 hours per week during the school year; 3 sessions: Fall, Winter and Spring. No weekly commitment necessary!
- **Age Requirement:** Must be at least 14 years of age.
- **Duties:** Assist in one of our theme-based afterschool clubs or summer SOAR program. Lead small group activities or provide one-on-one support for a student in the classroom.

Adult ESL Tutor

- **Length of Commitment:** 1 - 2 hours per week during the school year; and substitutes to be on-call. Full school year commitment.
- **Age Requirement:** Must be at least 15 years of age.
- **Responsibilities :** Weekly lead a one-hour adult ESL small group with up to four parents.

Office Support

- **Length of Commitment:** No minimum commitment required!
- **Age Requirement:** Must be at least 14 years of age.
- **Duties:** Support TLC staff in the afternoons with tutoring students, administrative tasks and study hall/ homework help sessions.

Can't commit to a program every week?

Volunteer as a substitute tutor and be on call when someone cannot make it!
