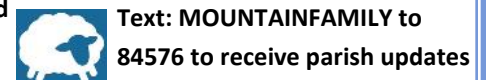
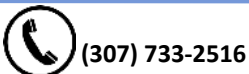

What are they saying about the readings today, and who?

An autobiography, *A Narrative of the Life and Labors of the Rev. G. W. Offley*, says, “Therefore we may be oppressed by man, but never morally degraded, only as we are made willing subjects to do sinful acts against what we know or have the power to know is wrong in the sight of God and man.

No difference how poor we are, if we are respectable, honest, and upright, with God, ourselves, and our fellow man. For St. Peter declares, **Acts 10:34-35**, “that God shows no partiality. In every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him.” And if any man is accepted with his God, then oppression, nor prejudice, or persons or chains, or whips, or anything formed by man, cannot degrade us. No, we must voluntarily subscribe to some mean act before we can be mean or low in the sight of our dear Lord and Master.

Helen Keller was the first blind and deaf person to earn a bachelor of arts degree (Redcliffe College). She was a prolific writer and lecturer who inspired many people. Phillips Brooks of Boston introduced a young Keller to the Christian faith. Writing about this relationship, she cited **1 John 4:8** as a primary influence in her thinking. “Bishop Brooks . . . impressed upon my mind two great ideas - the fatherhood of God and the brotherhood of man, and made me feel that these truths underlie all creeds and forms of worship. God is love, God is our Father, we are His children; therefore the darkest clouds will break, and though right be worsted, wrong shall not triumph.”



One of Jesus’s most inspirational statements is that the strong display of love is to lay down one’s life for a friend. This saying has appeared in countless books, poems, and songs. It has even appeared in comics, thanks to the writers of Batman and Robin.

In the episode titled “Gotham Gang Line-Up” Bruce Wayne’s butler, Alfred, is willing to die in order to save Batman and Robin. Alfred, Batman, and Robin were about to be crushed by rocks. Alfred pushed the other two out of the way, saving them from the rocks but leaving himself trapped and apparently crushed to death.

Thinking that his friend had perished, Batman exclaimed, “He gave his life so that we might live! No friend could do more.” **John 15:13.**

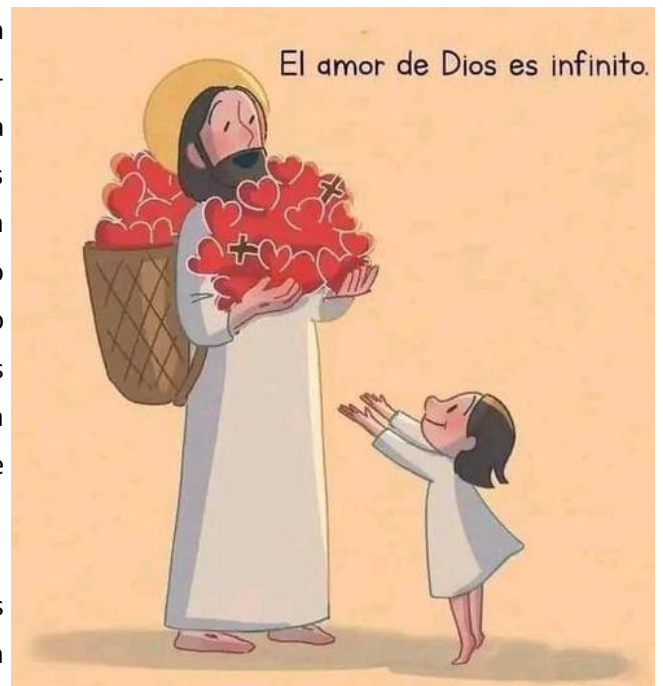
El 10 de octubre de 1982, en la gran plaza de San Pedro de Roma, el papa Juan Pablo II canonizó a un paisano suyo: Maximiliano Kolbe, sacerdote franciscano, nacido el 8 de enero de 1894 en la ciudad de Zdunska Wola. Estuvo presente en este acto un testigo excepcional: Franciszek Gajowniczek, un polaco ya anciano que, cuarenta y un años antes, había salvado su vida en el campo de concentración de Auschwitz, gracias al heroico gesto del nuevo santo.

Este hombre cuenta así su experiencia de aquel verano de 1941: “yo era un veterano en el campo de Auschwitz; tenía en mi brazo tatuado el número de inscripción: 5659. Una noche, al pasar los guardianes lista, uno de nuestros compañeros no respondió cuando leyeron su nombre. Se dio la alarma: los oficiales del campo desplegaron todos los dispositivos de seguridad; salieron patrullas por los alrededores. Aquella noche nos fuimos angustiados a nuestros barracones. Los dos mil internados en nuestro pabellón sabíamos que nuestra alternativa era bien trágica; si no lograbamos dar con el escapado, acabarían con diez de nosotros. A la mañana siguiente nos hicieron formar a todos los dos mil y nos tuvieron en posición de firmes desde las primeras horas hasta el mediodía. Nuestros cuerpos estaban debilitados al máximo por el trabajo y la escasísima alimentación. Muchos del grupo caían exánimes bajo aquel sol implacable. Hacia las tres nos dieron algo de comer y volvimos a la posición de firmes hasta la noche. El coronel Fritsch volvió a pasar lista y anunció que diez de nosotros seríamos ajusticiados.

A la mañana siguiente, Franciszek Gajowniczek fue uno de los diez elegidos por el coronel de la SS para ser ajusticiados en represalia por el escapado. Cuando Franciszek salió de su fila,

después de haber sido señalado por el coronel, dijo estas palabras: “Pobre esposa mía; pobres hijos míos”. El P. Maximiliano estaba cerca y oyó estas palabras. Enseguida, dio un paso adelante y le dijo al coronel: “Soy un sacerdote católico polaco, estoy ya viejo. Querría ocupar el puesto de ese hombre que tiene esposa e hijos”. Su ofrecimiento fue aceptado por el oficial nazi y Maximiliano Kolbe, que tenía entonces 47 años, fue condenado, junto con otros nueve prisioneros, a morir de hambre. Tres semanas después, el único prisionero que seguía vivo era el P. Kolbe, de modo que le fue aplicada una inyección letal que terminó definitivamente con su vida. Maximiliano Kolbe había vivido su ministerio pastoral en Polonia y Japón, donde había pasado cinco años como misionero. Con este gesto sellaba una vida de entrega permanente.

Jesús nos invita a amarnos como Él nos amó: “El amor más grande que uno puede tener es dar su vida por sus amigos”. No siempre se tratara de situaciones tan extremas como las que vivió san Maximiliano Kolbe, pero siempre el amor pasa por la entrega de la propia vida.

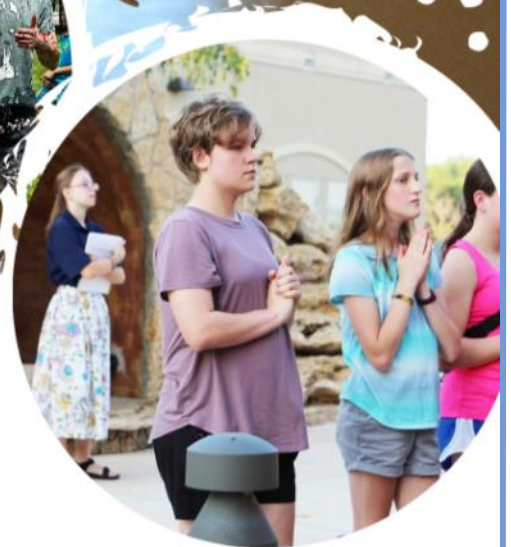

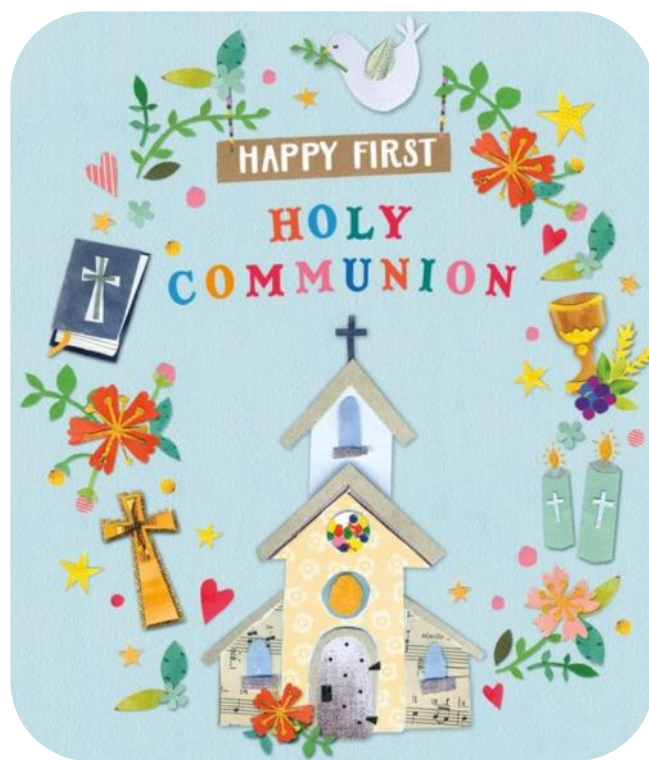


