
Today is the feast of Pentecost, sometimes called the Birthday of the Church. It's been around for twenty centuries, displaying sin and sanctity as you might expect of a church made up of human beings and not angels. As the media never lets us forget, two thousand years after the coming of the Holy Spirit, the world once again is unsafe and the church is once more battered by scandal and shame and has lost power, influence, and members.

But I want to suggest to you, that, under the Spirit, the church has seen the commencement of all the existing governments on this planet. It was there before the Saxons set foot in Britain, before the Franks crossed the Rhine, and before Grecian eloquence flourished in Antioch. No scandal has destroyed it; no betrayal by intimates has completely stilled its voice.

The church, the People of God, moves on steadily in spite of the worst horrors man could inflict on man. The early Christians, a minority persecuted fringe group, amid the greed and pride of the Roman Empire, were so caring and so giving, so kind to the sick and needy that they forced even their enemies to exclaim, "See those Christians; how they love one another."

There were the folk who established the monasteries, the Holiday Inns of the Dark Ages, that served as places of learning, refuge, hospice, and hospitality for many in a dangerous age when vandals and brigands freely roamed and pillaged the land. There were the Irish monks bringing civilization back to a Europe collapsed by war and conflict.

There were Aquinas and Ignatius who helped the church recover its intellectual and spiritual footings when it stumbled badly. And Michelangelo and Dante left us beauty in the midst of moral ugliness. And Benedict and Francis and Dominic, living in terrible, corrupt times, breathed into us a new spirit. There was Hildegard of Bingen, forerunner of the Broadway musical, and the Passion Plays, the forerunner of the modern theater. There was Thomas More, husband and father, laying down his life for principle while others rationalized.



There was Vincent de Paul and the Daughters of Charity taking in the homeless and poor, to be followed in another age by a Mother Cabrini and a Mother Teresa. Abraham Lincoln had high praise for the Catholic nuns who ministered heroically during the Civil War. There was Peter Claver caring for the slaves when others thought they were animals, divorced Rose Hawthorne caring for cancer victims society had abandoned, and Elizabeth Ann Seton opening schools for disenfranchised children.

My friends, among war and betrayal within and without the church, betrayals that would have toppled any other institution long ago, I tell you that Pentecost lives in the quiet heroism of many men and women, boys and girls of this age as it has in all the ages past.

After two thousand or so years of inhumanity, only the enduring Pentecostal Spirit could still invite us here and, amid our bewilderment and fear, bring us to celebrate a happy birthday.

So, let the red you are wearing cause you to take heart, give hope, and never cease to pray, "Come, Holy Spirit!"

Hacedores de la Palabra Pentecostés Domingo 19 de mayo de 2024 ¡Feliz cumpleaños!

Hoy es la fiesta de Pentecostés, a veces llamada el Cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Ha existido durante veinte siglos, mostrando el pecado y la santidad como se podría esperar de una iglesia formada por seres humanos y no por ángeles.. Como los medios de comunicación nunca nos permiten olvidar, dos mil años después de la venida del Espíritu Santo, el mundo una vez más es inseguro y la iglesia una vez más es golpeada por el escándalo y la vergüenza y ha perdido poder, influencia y miembros.

Pero quiero sugerirles que, bajo el Espíritu, la iglesia ha visto el comienzo de todos los gobiernos existentes en este planeta. Estaba allí antes de que los sajones pusieran un pie en Gran Bretaña, antes de que los franceses cruzaran el Rin y antes de que la elocuencia griega floreciera en Antioquía. Ningún escándalo la ha destruido; ninguna traición por parte de sus íntimos ha acallado completamente su voz

La iglesia, el Pueblo de Dios, avanza con paso firme a pesar de los peores horrores que el hombre pueda infligir al hombre. Los primeros cristianos, un grupo marginal minoritario perseguido, en medio de la codicia y el orgullo del Imperio Romano, eran tan bondadosos y generosos, tan amables con los enfermos y necesitados que obligaban incluso a sus enemigos a excluir: "Miren a esos cristianos; cómo se aman unos a otros". Estaban las personas que establecieron los monasterios, los Holiday Inn de la Edad Media, que sirvieron como lugares de aprendizaje, refugio, hospicio y hospitalidad para muchos en una época peligrosa en la que vándalos y bandidos vagababan libremente y saqueaban la tierra. Estaban los monjes irlandeses que devolvieron la civilización a una Europa colapsada por la guerra y el conflicto.


Estuvieron Tomás de Aquino e Ignacio quienes ayudaron a la iglesia a recuperar sus bases intelectuales y espirituales cuando tropezó gravemente, y Miguel Ángel y Dante nos dejaron la belleza en medio de la fealdad moral. Y Benito, Francisco y Domingo, viviendo en tiempos terribles y corruptos, nos inspiraron un espíritu nuevo. Estaba Hildegarda de Bingen, precursora del musical de Broadway, y Passion Plays, precursora del teatro moderno. Estaba Tomás Moro, esposo y padre, que dio su vida por principios mientras otros racionalizaban.

Estaba Vicente de Paúl y las Hijas de la Caridad acogiendo a los pobres y sin hogar, a los que seguirían en otra época una Madre Cabrini y una Madre Teresa. Abraham Lincoln elogió mucho a las monjas católicas que ministraron heroicamente durante la Guerra Civil. Estaba Peter Claver cuidando a los esclavos cuando otros pensaban que eran animales, la divorciada Rose Hawthorne cuidando a las víctimas de cáncer que la sociedad había abandonado y Elizabeth Ann Seton abriendo escuelas para niños privados de sus derechos.

Amigos míos, entre guerras y traiciones dentro y fuera de la iglesia, traiciones que habrían derribado a cualquier otra institución hace mucho tiempo, les digo que Pentecostés vive en el heroísmo silencioso de muchos hombres y mujeres, niños y niñas de esta época como lo ha hecho en todas las edades pasadas.

Después de aproximadamente dos mil años de inhumanidad, sólo el perdurable Espíritu Pentecostal todavía podría invitarnos aquí y, en medio de nuestro desconcierto y miedo, traernos a celebrar un feliz cumpleaños.

Así que deja que el rojo que llevas te haga animarte, dar esperanza y nunca dejar de orar: "¡Ven, Espíritu Santo!"




Evening Eucharistic Adoration:

The Men's Faith Group is gearing up for an exciting program to begin this Fall at OLM.






