Fr. Louie's corner

Did Jesus call Peter Satan? Right after he told him he was the rock on which he would build his church? He sure does in our Gospel this reading this week! What he meant by that was that Peter was tempting him, was testing his loyalty to the Father. Peter has human plans and hopes for who Jesus is and what he will accomplish. He wants Jesus to be a conquering messiah that will run the Romans out of Israel. Jesus has other plans. He will follow the will of his Father with exacting fidelity. Peter continues to be a great example for us, of what to do and also what not to do. We are supposed to obey God, God does not obey us. We so often put our mind to human things rather than divine things. Jesus tells his disciples that we must take up our cross and follow Him. Through the millennia this has lost the shock value that it would have had for the disciples of Jesus' time. The reality of the torturous death that it symbolized in Jesus' time can be lost on us. We are called to take up our cross and follow Jesus. That means that we are to be willing to give up anything, suffer anything as His disciples. It is a difficult ask and each of us are probably all going to resist that calling at times. We each have to work out how that will work in our lives: just like Peter did.

¿Llamó Jesús a Pedro "Satanás"? ¿Justo después de decirle que él era la roca sobre la que edificaría su Iglesia? ¡Ciertamente lo hace en el Evangelio de esta semana! Lo que quería decir con ello era que Pedro lo estaba tentando, poniendo a prueba su lealtad al Padre. Pedro alberga planes y esperanzas humanas sobre quién es Jesús y lo que logrará; quiere que Jesús sea un mesías conquistador que expulse a los romanos de Israel. Jesús tiene otros planes: cumplirá la voluntad de su Padre con absoluta fidelidad. Pedro sigue siendo un gran ejemplo para nosotros, tanto de lo que debemos hacer como de lo que no. Nosotros debemos obedecer a Dios; Dios no nos obedece a nosotros. Con frecuencia pensamos más en las cosas humanas que en las divinas. Jesús dice a sus discípulos que debemos tomar nuestra cruz y seguirle. Con el paso de los milenios, esto ha perdido el impacto que habría tenido para los discípulos de la época de Jesús; podemos llegar a perder de vista la realidad de la muerte atroz que aquello simbolizaba en aquel entonces. Estamos llamados a tomar nuestra cruz y seguir a Jesús. Eso significa estar dispuestos a renunciar a todo y a sufrirlo todo como discípulos suyos. Es una exigencia difícil, y es probable que todos nos resistamos a esa llamada en algún momento. Cada uno de nosotros debe descubrir cómo se traduce esto en su propia vida, tal como hizo Pedro.

Lucy Spotts is a 23-year-old Catholic recording artist, songwriter, worship leader, and performer. Known for her viral presence as a surfer, storyteller, and singer, Lucy brings that same passion and authenticity to Catholic Parishes, youth and young adult ministries. Based in New Smyrna Beach, Florida, Lucy spent some of her most formative years in Thayne and Jackson Hole, as a parishioner of Holy Family and OLM where she was Confirmed. Her original songs, including "Get Your Hopes Up", "Sacred Anointing", "INJ (I Need Jesus)", "Available," and "Stay In The Fight," have become powerful anthems of hope, healing, and identity in Christ for people of all ages. New songs, "Beyond Imagination" (co-written with Tom Booth and Josh Blakesley), and "Wild" will release this Fall. Since age 17, Lucy has released 41 original songs and is currently working new worship projects with Echo Harbor Worship. Behind every lyric and melody is her mission—to create spaces where people can encounter the living God through music, prayer, and vulnerability. Whether leading Adoration, sharing her testimony, or lifting hearts in a high-energy worship set, Lucy invites every soul to lean fully into the presence of Jesus—the One who carried her through anxiety, fear, and aimlessness into joy, peace, and purpose. In Fall 2025, Lucy served as a Worship leader with Echo Harbor at NCYC at the Lucas Oil Stadium for over 17,000 youth. She will be back this year for NCYC in Long Beach, CA.

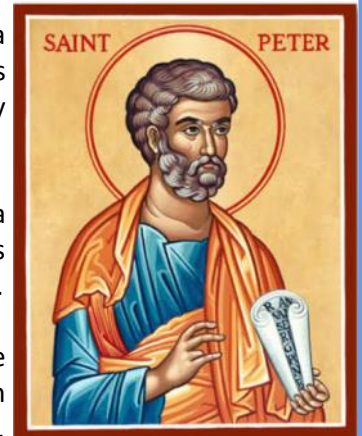

Peter liked to take charge and set his own agenda. But he found himself in over his head:

- When Jesus walked on water, Peter tried to confirm Jesus' identity by demanding an invitation to join Him on the water. After a few steps, Peter was overwhelmed by the wind and the waves and sank in fear. (Matt. 14:22-32).
- Peter exaggerated his commitment to Christ, claiming that "even if I have to die with You, I will not deny You!" (26:35). Only a few hours later he denied having any connection to Jesus (26:69-75).
- Peter tried to singlehandedly defend Jesus against Roman soldiers who came to arrest Him, even though he had failed to "watch and pray" with Christ (26:36-46; John 18:1-11).
- Peter refused to let Jesus wash his feet at the Last Supper, then begged Him to wash his hands, feet, and head as well (13:5-11).

Peter's leadership impulses were eventually brought under control, and he became a significant figure in the early church. Despite the false starts that resulted from Peter's impetuous nature, Peter grew up. Jesus enlisted this loyal follower to "feed my sheep" (21:17).



Like Peter, our leadership skills may be raw. We might be ready to jump at the first idea that enters our mind. We can instead let Jesus harness our energies and talents for His glory. He has a plan for our growth, and it may require slowing down before speeding up.

During those final days and hours, Jesus' followers began to fall apart. When the moment of decision came they deserted their Lord. (Mt 26:56). When Jesus asked them to keep watch with Him during His final hours of freedom, they twice fell asleep (Mt. 26:40,43). As Jesus endured mockery and beatings, Peter, who had led the others to vowing their loyalty (26:35), denied even knowing his Master (26:69-75).

The disciples hardly seem to have had what was needed to continue the work that Jesus began. But even after an experience of excruciating suffering and glorious resurrection, Jesus returned to these same followers and announced that they were still His chosen leaders to continue His work. He even affirmed his commitment to stick with them to the end (28:19,20).

Jesus' treatment of the disciples shows that failure is not an unforgivable act. In fact, it seems to be necessary to create character. It is not meant to eliminate but to transform the weak and wavering. Christ does not look for perfect people but for faithful followers who will experience His forgiveness, and move to learn and grow. Hopefully we are among them!

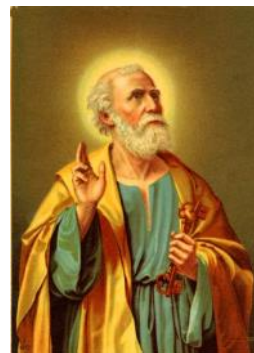

A Pedro le gustaba tomar la iniciativa y marcar su propia agenda. Pero se vio superado por las circunstancias:

- Cuando Jesús caminó sobre las aguas, Pedro intentó confirmar la identidad de Jesús exigiendo una invitación para acompañarlo sobre el agua. Tras dar unos pocos pasos, Pedro se vio abrumado por el viento y las olas, y se hundió presa del miedo (Mt 14, 22-32).
- Pedro exageró su compromiso con Cristo, afirmando: "¡Aunque tenga que morir contigo, no te negaré!" (26, 35). Apenas unas horas más tarde, negó tener vínculo alguno con Jesús (26, 69-75).
- Pedro intentó defender a Jesús por su cuenta frente a los soldados romanos que venían a arrestarlo, a pesar de no haber logrado "velar y orar" con Cristo (26, 36-46; Jn 18, 1-11).
- Pedro se negó a dejar que Jesús le lavara los pies en la Última Cena, pero luego le suplicó que le lavara también las manos, los pies y la cabeza (13, 5-11).

Con el tiempo, los impulsos de liderazgo de Pedro fueron encauzados y se convirtió en una figura clave de la Iglesia primitiva. A pesar de los tropiezos iniciales derivados de su naturaleza impetuosa, Pedro maduró. Jesús encomendó a este fiel seguidor la misión de "apacentar mis ovejas" (21, 17).

Al igual que Pedro, nuestras habilidades de liderazgo pueden estar aún sin pulir. Es posible que estemos dispuestos a lanzarnos a la primera idea que nos cruza por la mente. En cambio, podemos permitir que Jesús canalice nuestras energías y talentos para su gloria. Él tiene un plan para nuestro crecimiento, y este puede requerir que bajemos el ritmo antes de acelerar.



Durante aquellos últimos días y horas, los seguidores de Jesús comenzaron a desmoronarse. Cuando llegó el momento de decidir, abandonaron a su Señor (Mt 26, 56). Cuando Jesús les pidió que velaran con Él durante sus últimas horas de libertad, se quedaron dormidos en dos ocasiones (Mt 26, 40-43). Mientras Jesús soportaba las burlas y los golpes, Pedro —quien había guiado a los demás a jurar lealtad (26:35)— negó incluso conocer a su Maestro (26:69-75).

Parece que los discípulos apenas contaban con lo necesario para continuar la obra que Jesús había iniciado. Sin embargo, incluso después de vivir una experiencia de sufrimiento atroz y una resurrección gloriosa, Jesús volvió a estos mismos seguidores y anunció que seguían siendo los líderes elegidos para continuar su obra. Incluso reafirmó su compromiso de permanecer con ellos hasta el fin (28:19-20).

La manera en que Jesús trató a los discípulos demuestra que el fracaso no es un acto imperdonable. De hecho, parece ser necesario para forjar el carácter. Su propósito no es eliminar a los débiles e indecisos, sino transformarlos. Cristo no busca personas perfectas, sino seguidores fieles que experimenten su perdón y avancen aprendiendo y creciendo. ¡Ojalá nos contemos entre ellos!

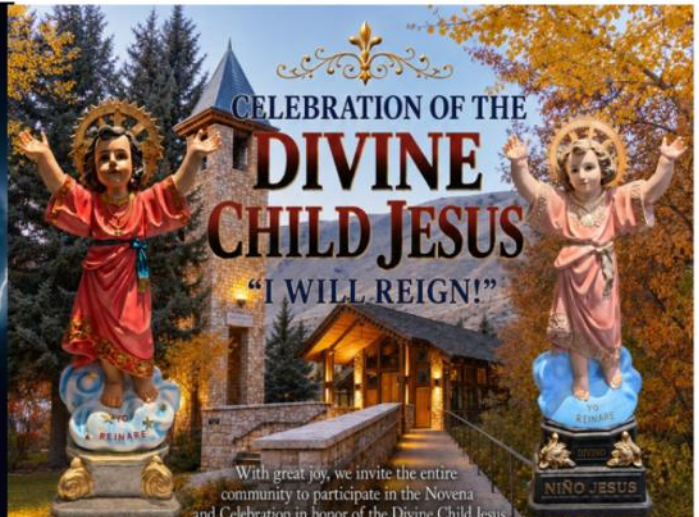

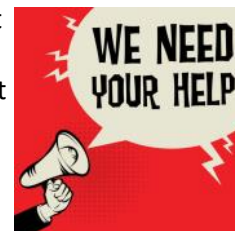
