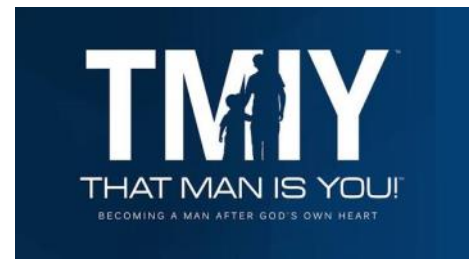


Men of Our Lady of The Mountains Parish

Cuando Jesús ordenó a sus discípulos: «Vayan... y hagan discípulos» (Mateo 28:19), el objetivo de ellos no era acumular seguidores para sí mismos, sino ganar nuevos discípulos para su Señor. No hacían discípulos llevando a las personas a tomar decisiones espirituales para luego dejarlas a su suerte; por el contrario, los apóstoles se volcaban en el desarrollo espiritual continuo de individuos y comunidades.

La mentoría es tan antigua como *La Odisea* de Homero (c. 900-810 a. C.), obra en la que el protagonista, Odiseo, confía la educación de su hijo Telémaco a un amigo llamado Mentor. Un mentor es un consejero o guía de confianza —a menudo alguien mayor y con más experiencia— que transmite sabiduría valiosa para ayudar a otra persona a crecer y madurar.

El Antiguo Testamento está lleno de relaciones de mentoría:

- **Jetró, un acaudalado ganadero, ayudó a su yerno Moisés —quien estaba sobrecargado de trabajo— a aprender a delegar autoridad (Éxodo 18:1-27).**
- **Débora, jueza de Israel, convocó a Barac para ejercer el liderazgo militar y lo impulsó a lograr la victoria sobre el rey cananeo Jabín, asegurando así cuarenta años de paz (Jueces 4:4-24).**
- **Elí, sacerdote del Señor que fracasó como padre, logró formar al joven Samuel para que le sucediera (1 Samuel 1:1–3:21).**
- **El profeta Elías presenció la caída de Acab y Jezabel, y luego transfirió su ministerio al joven Eliseo, quien recibió una doble porción de su espíritu (2 Reyes 2:1-15).**



Un mentor ejemplar en el Nuevo Testamento es Bernabé, un terrateniente adinerado de la iglesia primitiva que se convirtió en defensor y guía de Saulo, antiguo enemigo y perseguidor de los cristianos. Gracias a la orientación y el ánimo que recibió de Bernabé, Saulo (más tarde llamado Pablo) se convirtió en una figura central en los esfuerzos de la iglesia primitiva por difundir el evangelio. Pablo llegó a ser mentor de otros cristianos de los inicios de la Iglesia, destacando entre ellos Timoteo, el joven pastor de la iglesia de Éfeso.

Un mentor vela por los intereses de la otra persona. Su ejemplo y orientación conducen, con el tiempo, a delegar responsabilidades en sus seguidores. Los mentores corrigen a sus discípulos; por ejemplo, Bernabé cuestionó la actitud negativa de Pablo hacia Juan Marcos e insistió en que llevaran a su joven discípulo consigo en un segundo viaje misionero (Hechos 15:36-39). Más tarde, Pablo cambió de parecer y pidió a Timoteo que le llevara a Juan Marcos. Los mentores no rehúyen la confrontación. Los mentores ponen a sus discípulos en contacto con personas y recursos que impulsarán su desarrollo y aumentarán sus oportunidades de crecimiento y éxito. La mentoría puede marcar la diferencia entre el éxito y el fracaso en la vida de una persona.

Since age 17, Lucy has released 41 original songs and is currently working new worship projects with Echo Harbor Worship. Whether leading Adoration, sharing her testimony, or lifting hearts in a high-energy worship set, Lucy invites every soul to lean fully into the presence of Jesus—the One who carried her through anxiety, fear, and aimlessness into joy, peace, and purpose. In Fall 2025, Lucy served as a Worship leader with Echo Harbor at NCYC at the Lucas Oil Stadium for over 17,000 youth. She will be back this year for NCYC in Long Beach, CA.

When Jesus commanded His disciples to “Go. . . and make disciples” (Matt. 28:19), their objective was not to collect followers for themselves but to win new disciples for their Lord. They did not make disciples by bringing people to spiritual decisions and then leaving them to fend for themselves. The apostles instead poured themselves into the ongoing spiritual development of individuals and communities.

Mentoring is as old as the Odyssey of Homer (c. 900-810 B.C.), in which the protagonist Odysseus entrusts the education of his son Telemachus to his friend, named Mentor. A mentor is a trusted counsellor or guide, often someone older and more experienced, who imparts valuable wisdom to help another person grow and mature.

The Old Testament is filled with mentoring relationships:

- **Jethro the wealthy livestock owner helped his overworked son-in-law- Moses learn to delegate authority (Ex. 18:1-27).**
- **Deborah, judge over Israel, summoned Barak to military leadership and pushed him to victory over the Canaanite king Jabin, securing forty years of peace (Judg. 4:4-24).**
- **Eli, a priest of the Lord who failed as a father, successfully raised young Samuel to succeed him (1 Sam. 1-3:21).**
- **The prophet Elijah oversaw the demise of Ahab and Jezebel, then passed his office on to young Elisha, who received a double portion of his spirit (2 Kings 2:1-15).**



A model mentor in the New Testament is **Barnabas**, a wealthy land owner in the early

church, who became an advocate and guide for Saul, the former enemy and persecutor of Christians. Because of the coaching and encouragement he received from Barnabas, Saul (later called Paul) became a central figure in the early church's efforts to spread the gospel. Paul went on to become a mentor to several other early Christians, notable Timothy, the young pastor of the church at Ephesus.

A mentor looks out for the interests of the other. Their modeling and coaching eventually lead to handing responsibility over to their followers. Mentors correct their followers, for example, Barnabas challenged Paul's negative attitude about John Mark and urged him to take their young disciple along on a second missionary journey (Acts 15:36-39). Paul later changed his perspective and asked Timothy to bring John Mark to him. Mentors do not shy away from confrontation. Mentors introduce their followers to relationships and resources that will further their development and increase opportunities for growth and success. Mentoring can mean the difference between success and failure in a person's life.

Who are your role models? To whom does God want for you to be a role model?

Fr. Louie's corner

Have you ever gone directly to your brother to point out his faults to him? Maybe it did not work out very well. Then take a couple friends with you to let him know what his problems are. You probably will not have to take the issue to the church because he is unlikely to be on speaking terms with you anymore. We have to remember who is telling us how to handle this. It is Jesus, and so for this to work we have to go about it the way Jesus would: which means with love. Only with our brother's, or sister's, best interest at heart can this have a chance of working. Jesus is giving advice here about the best way to get another Christian to see the error of his ways. This is a loving instruction of how to use God's love to bring back one of us who has strayed through sinfulness.

¿Alguna vez has acudido directamente a tu hermano para señalarle sus faltas? Quizás no resultó muy bien. Entonces, lleva contigo a un par de amigos para hacerle ver cuáles son sus problemas.

Es Jesús; por tanto, para que funcione, debemos hacerlo como lo haría Él: con amor. Solo si realmente buscamos el bien de nuestro hermano o hermana, esto tendrá alguna posibilidad de éxito. Aquí, Jesús aconseja sobre la mejor manera de hacer que otro cristiano reconozca su error. Se trata de una instrucción amorosa sobre cómo utilizar el amor de Dios para recuperar a uno de los nuestros que se ha extraviado a causa del pecado.
